Whilst reflecting on practices involving new technologies, tributes to tradition and craftsmanship are paid through the disclosure of conception and production processes.

By proposing challenging projects and immersive experiences, the show encourages visitors to actively participate and interact with the presented works. The exhibition provides an engaging and creative environment where senses and perceptions are awakened, and reflections on important contemporary topics are stimulated.




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
